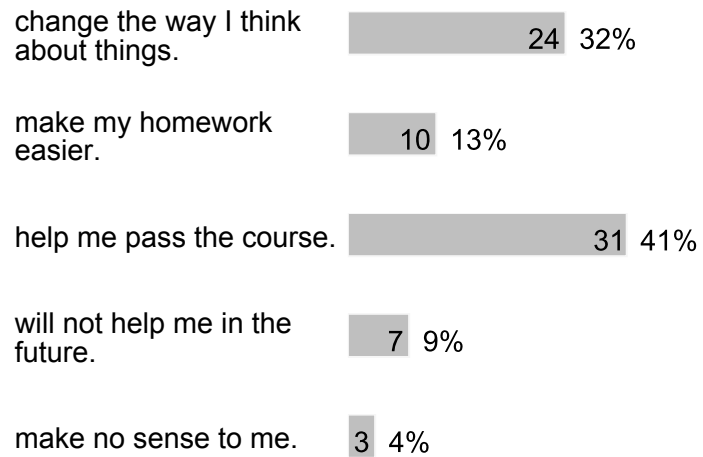

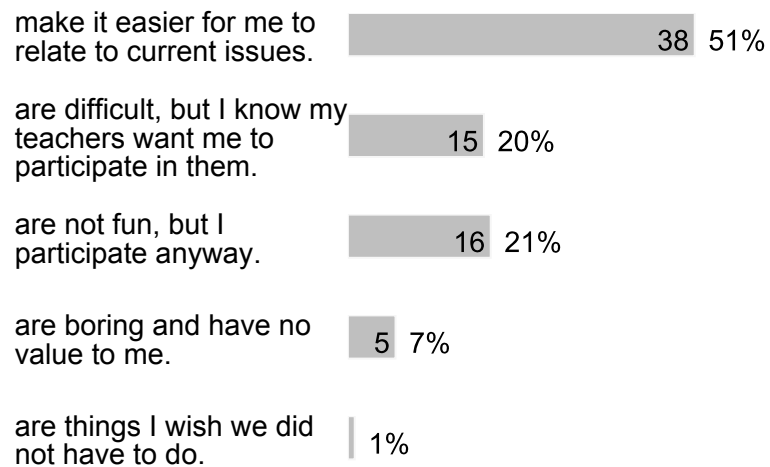

12. 12. The skills I am learning in class...



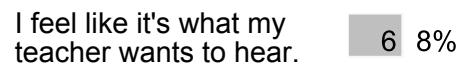

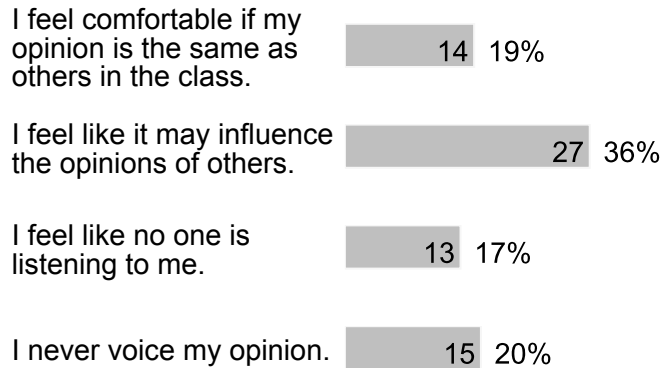
13. 13. Classroom activities...

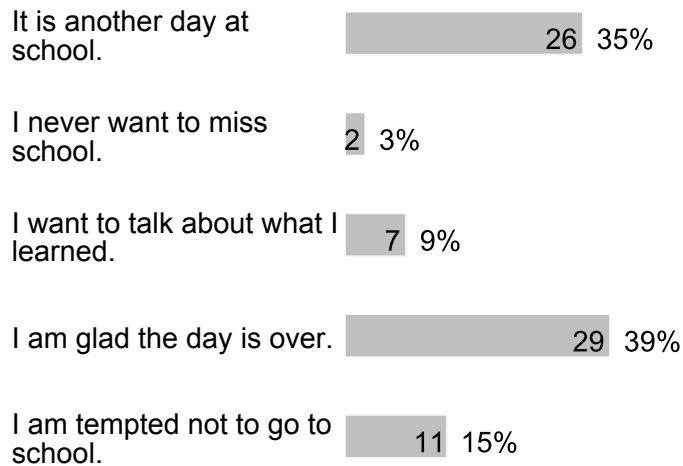
14. 14. How do you feel when you are voicing your opinion in class?





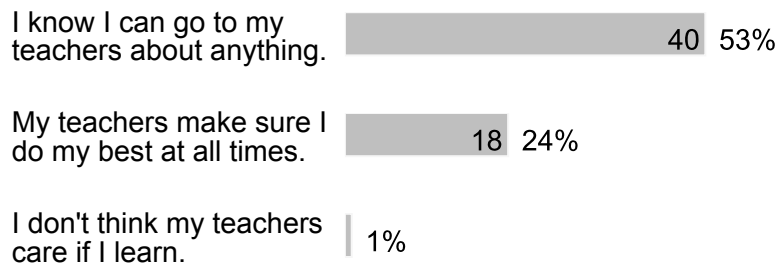
