# HAGERMAN JOINT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 233 REGULAR MEETING OF THE SCHOOL BOARD HELD JANUARY 12, 2015

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Hagerman Joint School District No. 233, Gooding and Twin Falls Counties, Idaho, was convened at 7:00 p.m. on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2015, in the Media Center of the Hagerman Jr/Sr High School, Hagerman, Idaho, pursuant to authority provided by ID Section 33-510.

# A. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting opened at 6:00pm with Chairman Karl Emerson presiding.

# B. ROLL CALL

Present were Chairman Karl Emerson, Vice Chairman Mark Daily, Treasurer Harry DeWolfe, and Trustee Monte Osborne and Trustee Chuck Steele. Also present was Superintendent Eric Anderson, Principal Mark Kress and District Clerk Bette Reed.

Visitors included Anna Ray, Angie Lauritzen, Lora Silver-Lewis, Jamie Hess, Jessica Knapp and Matt Cottam.

# C. CONSENT AGENDA

Motion (Daily/DeWolfe) Carried to approve the consent agenda as presented.

Questions: Clerk Reed explained there will be an additional \$800-\$1000 to IT for elementary & jr/sr high school copy machine clicks once the invoices have been reviewed. There was a problem with the new machines and payment of invoices did not include those with the new machines. Chairman Emerson asked about the room reservations for the Girls and Boys basketball tournaments.

# D. REPORTS

- 1. Superintendent Eric Anderson:
  - The Christmas concert had an excellent turnout, well organized and done in one (1) hour. The kids had a good time and the theme baskets made around \$1,000;
