The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Hagerman Joint School District No. 233, Gooding and Twin Falls Counties, Idaho, was convened at 8:00 p.m. on the 9^h day of January, 2018, in the Media Center of the Hagerman Jr/Sr High School, Hagerman, Idaho, pursuant to authority provided by ID Section 74-206.

A. CALL TO ORDER

B. CONSENT AGENDA
