The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Hagerman Joint School District No. 233, Gooding and Twin Falls Counties, Idaho, was convened at 7:00 p.m. on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2014, in the Media Center of the Hagerman Jr/Sr High School, Hagerman, Idaho, pursuant to authority provided by ID Section 33-510.

### A. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting opened at 7:00pm with Chairman Karl Emerson presiding.

#### B. ROLL CALL

Present were Chairman Karl Emerson, Vice Chairman Mark Daily, Treasurer Harry DeWolfe, and Trustee Monte Osborne and Trustee Chuck Steele. Also present was Superintendent Eric Anderson, Principal Mark Kress and District Clerk Bette Reed.

#### C. CONSENT AGENDA

*Motion* (DeWolfe/Daily) Carried to approve the consent agenda as presented.

  - Good questions from participants from School Improvement meeting held November 13, 2014.
     Working on Goal 5 which is to Increase Community Engagement & Communication. The webpage has an area for a superintendent's report and now have a vast number of emails to send out updates;
  - Attended a National Park Service meeting along with several teachers form the both schools.
     Discussion held on various programs available to classrooms and free busing for field trips. Both the school and the Park Service will be holding a Career Fair Day sometime in February along with other small local schools. The goal is to allow local students to find job opportunities available through local opportunities;
  - Christmas concert and silent auction to be held December 17, 2014 at 7:00pm in the old gym.
  - State safety maintenance conducted with a few findings. Some of the repeats was the extension cord being used on a projector, the wrong backflow valve used in the concession stand and the fire door in the elementary school;
