HJSD Parents, Thanks again for your support and trust in the Hagerman School District. I'd like to share a brief update on our focus areas and goals for the 2021-22 school year.

Goal #1: 72% of our students in grades 3-6 will show one year of growth on their end-of year ISAT assessments from 2021 to 2022 scores in both Math and ELA.

Goal #2: 72% of our students in grades K-3 will be proficient according to the i-station results by May of 2022 in both Reading and Math.

Goal #3: All staff are committed to implementing ITBS as a school wide effort by attending and participating in teaming trainings, monthly professional development and holding one another accountable. Teachers will reinforce positive behaviors with "ARRGH" stamps. Teachers will model each virtue of "ARRGH."
