# Elementary Building Goals 2022-23

Goal #1: 70% of our students in grades 4-6 will be proficient or display one year of growth according to the i-station results by April of 2023 in both Reading and Math.

Goal #2: 72% of our students in grades K-3 will be proficient or display one year of growth according to the i-station results by April of 2023 in both Reading and Math.

Goal #3: All staff are committed to implementing ITBS as a school wide effort by attending and participating in teaming trainings, monthly professional development and holding one another accountable.

- Teachers will reinforce positive behaviors with "ARRGH" stamps/ticket weekly.
- Teachers will model each virtue of "ARRGH."

Goal #4: All Hagerman Elementary staff members will implement "GRIT." Each grade level will implement an aspect of "GRIT" in each of their classrooms including:

- a. Kdg. Learning binder organization
  - -learning how to organize desk and work space with materials needed
- b. 1st Daily binder check
- c. 2<sup>nd</sup> Daily binder/agenda check
  - -writing three agenda items that are done daily
  - -learning note taking strategies in math
- d. 3<sup>rd</sup> Daily binder/agenda checks.
  - -WICOR is implemented daily across curriculum
- e. 4th Daily binder/agenda checks.
  - -WICOR is implemented daily across the curriculum
  - -Star note taking is utilized in science journals.
  - -Acronyms are discussed to understand the AVID program.
- f. 5<sup>th</sup> –Daily binder/agenda checks.
  - WICOR is implemented daily in all content areas.
- g. 6<sup>th</sup> Daily binder/agenda checks.

-Implementing focused note taking strategies with an emphasis on answering an essential question.

-WICOR is implemented daily across the curriculum.
